Whale Shark Interaction Guidelines

CODE OF CONDUCT

- MINIMIZE SPLASHING WHEN ENTERING THE WATER
- DO NOT TOUCH THE WHALE SHARK
- Do not obstruct the animal's path
- DO NOT USE MOTORIZED SCOOTERS
- No flash photography
- STAY 3M (10FT) AWAY FROM THE HEAD & 4M (13FT) AWAY FROM THE TAIL
- IN THE EVENT THE ANIMAL TURNS TOWARDS YOU, MAKE YOUR BEST EFFORT TO RETURN TO THE SIDE OF ITS BODY WITH APPROPRIATE DISTANCE
- IF UNCERTAIN, LOOK FOR DIRECTION FROM BOAT CREW
- BE COURTEOUS OF OTHER SWIMMERS
